

Boy Scout Troop 2222 Transportation

Troop 2222 continues to grow very rapidly. With our size and the great number of outings, the scheduling of transportation for these events must be done well in advance. We do not want to deprive any Scout of attending a troop event due to a lack of transportation. Dads are also more than welcome to attend outings with their sons and should notify the outing leader that they wish to attend a particular trip.

If you and/or your son are planning to attend an outing, it is very important that the outing leader be notified at least two weeks before the outing you will be attending. A boy or adult must attend both troop meetings the two weeks prior to the outing. If you must for some reason cancel, please contact the outing leader immediately so that we may adjust the transportation and the food.

If you sign up to drive on an outing **and** are a driver designated by the outing leader to drive, it is very important that you fulfill that obligation or find a replacement driver to fill-in for you. The outing leader **must** be notified of all driver substitutions.

If you are a driver designated by the outing leader, you may receive reimbursement for your fuel if you choose. You must follow these procedures if you plan to request fuel reimbursement:

1. Please fill your tank before you leave.
2. Upon return **refill** your tank and submit all **refill receipts** to the outing leader no later than 14 days after the outing. **Receipts submitted later than 14 days after an outing will not be reimbursed.**

We would like to see each family participate in driving for at least two outings per year.

In order to provide proper transportation for your son(s), you will need to **completely** fill out and return the **Troop 2222 Transportation Vehicle Information and Driver Statement** form. The form is available from and should be returned to the Troop Registrar. The information you furnish will only be made available to Troop leadership and BSA offices, as needed

The outing leader has the authority to limit the number of drivers on an outing as conditions dictate.

**TROOP 2222 TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE INFORMATION
AND DRIVER STATEMENT**

All persons who drive privately owned vehicles for any Boy Scout purpose must have a valid California Driver's License and should be an adult 21 years of age or older.

All drivers and vehicles used for Boy Scout activities must be covered by a public liability and property damage liability insurance policy. The amount of this coverage must meet or exceed the insurance requirement of the state in which the vehicle is licensed. However, it is recommended that coverage limits are at least: \$50,000 each person; \$100,000 each accident; \$50,000 property damage.
